## Some BIG Facts about Clifford

- Scholastic will celebrate the 50 anniversary of Clifford the Big Red Dog in the 2012-2013 school year including the 'BIGGEST' Birthday Party ever in New York City on September 24; the event will be streamed live to classrooms nationwide.
- There are more than 126 million Clifford books in print in 13 languages; the first Clifford book, *Clifford the Big Red Dog* was published in 1963.
- The animated Clifford television show is in its  $12^{th}$  consecutive season on PBS KIDS  $^{(8)}$ ; it has been sold to more than 30 countries worldwide.
- The series' educational messages, Clifford's Big Ideas (Share, Help Others, Be Kind, Be Responsible, Play Fair, Be a Good Friend, Believe in Yourself, Have Respect, Work Together and Be Truthful) focus on simple, tangible life lessons that are designed to help young children navigate their world as they become part of an ever-expanding community.
- The character Emily Elizabeth from the Clifford book series is named after Norman Bridwell's daughter Emily Elizabeth.
- Norman Bridwell has been married to his wife Norma for more than 50 years.
- Norman Bridwell was born and raised in Kokemo, Indiana.
- Clifford was originally to be called "Tiny," but instead was named "Clifford" after an imaginary childhood friend of Norma Bridwell's.
- Clifford stars in his very own live touring musical, scheduled to visit more than 50 cities during the anniversary year.
- Clifford is also the star of a travelling museum exhibit called "Adventures with Clifford the Big Red Dog".
- The BE BIGTM campaign launched in 2009 and invites everyone to take action and raise awareness for how Clifford's BIG Ideas can make the world a better place. Its mission is to recognize and reward others for their BIG actions, to catalyze change in local communities, and to provide resources for everyone to share BIG ideas.
